





LOCAL LEVEL

- It would accelerate the **process of implementing and formalizing the CLPs and university support** networks.
- Implement the **Benchmarks** as tools for monitoring competitiveness and management.
- Move forward with technical support from **Logistical Roadmaps** (HdRLog).
- **Expand areas of collaborative work: port city, energy efficiency, scope3 decarbonization, digitalization, etc.**

NATIONAL LEVEL

- Promote national logistics and port strategies with a focus on **logistics governance**
- Encourage **innovation projects**
- Disseminate the **principles of the Lima Declaration** to the highest authorities of each country
- **Strengthen port public policy**

REGIONAL LEVEL

- Link the Network with **regional integration schemes**
- Promote a **Regional Agenda** for Port Logistics Transformation 2030
- Achieve **interoperability between regional PCS**
