



Finance Facility Activities


Eligible activities:

- **Project preparation** includes full **feasibility studies** but also partial due diligence to meet “ready to finance” requirements, including environmental and social safeguards.
- **Capacity building** enhancing relevant know-how, institutional capacity in areas such as E&S safeguards, trade facilitation, debt sustainability.

Eligible Sectors:

- Energy
- Transport and logistics— including **ports**
- Transboundary Water
- ICT






PROJECTS PER SUPPORT TYPE




FINANCING AMOUNT BY SUPPORT TYPE

MCDF supports the ports sector

Direct support:

Extending grants for the modernization of existing ports and creation of new ones.

Indirect Support:

Building infrastructure to access ports but also to decongest traffic within and around their vicinity.

CAF	Ecuador	Project Preparation	Galapagos Logistics Infrastructure and Sustainability Investment Project	3,675,000	To support efforts to improve port infrastructure and logistics services for the delivery of food and other goods to the Galápagos Islands.
AIIB	Indonesia	Project Concept Development	Indonesia: Project to Optimize Regional Transport (PORT)	157,500	To support a diagnostic study of Indonesia's maritime sector, identification of potential investment projects for enhancing port infrastructure and maritime equipment supply chains, and a preliminary study of selected prospective investments.
AfDB	Seychelles	Project Concept Development	Development of Strategic Investment Plan for Seychelles Ports Authority for Period 2025-2030	157,500	Early project preparation work on a 2025-2030 strategic ports investment plan for the Seychelles Port Authority.
AIIB	Maldives	Project Concept Development	Maldives Uthuru-Thilafalhu-Thilafushi Link Project	157,500	Early technical assistance for constructing a 4.32km link comprised of roads and a 2.6km bridge. The link will facilitate people and goods flows between major ports including Malé Port.
AIIB	Côte d'Ivoire	Project Preparation	Greater Abidjan Freight Barge Transport Development Project	4,299,750	The underlying project involves a barge corridor along the Ébrié Lagoon to connect a planned terminal platform with the Autonomous Port of Abidjan.
AfDB	Multi-country	Capacity Building	African Ports Portals Connectivity	2,150,316	To facilitate investment in the ports and maritime sector by addressing data gaps and measuring port performance. The activities include a port data book, a web-based tool for collecting, storing, and retrieving African port data; and an African ports index with benchmarking sub-indices that cover key thematic areas in port operations and development planning.
